The Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Radioactivity in Sheep) Partial Revocation (Scotland) Order 2004

## Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Radioactivity in Sheep) Partial Revocation (Scotland) Order 2004 and shall come into force on 10th February 2004.
- (2) In this Order, "the principal Order" means the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Radioactivity in Sheep) Order 1991(1).

## Revocation

- **2.**—(1) The principal Order is revoked in so far as it designates any part of the area set out in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- (2) Part II of Schedule 1 to the principal Order shall be amended in accordance with Schedule 2 to this Order.
