#### **EXECUTIVE NOTE**

## The Scottish Homes (Dissolution) Order 2005 (SSI 2005/609)

The above instrument was made in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 87(1) and 109(2) of the Housing (Scotland) Act 2001. The instrument is subject to negative resolution procedure.

# **Policy Objectives**

The functions of Scottish Homes were transferred to Scottish Ministers in November 2001, and the act also provided for the eventual dissolution of the non-departmental body known as Scottish Homes. Three earlier property orders have transferred all remaining property and liabilities of Scottish Homes to Scottish Ministers: the Housing (Scotland) Act 2001 (Transfer of Scottish Homes Property etc) Order 2001 (SSI 2001/396); the Housing (Scotland) Act 2001 (Transfer of Scottish Homes Property and Liabilities) Order 2003 (SSI 2003/532); and the Housing (Scotland) Act 2001 (Transfer of Scottish Homes Property and Liabilities) Order 2005 (SSI 2005/439). This final instrument enables the dissolution of Scottish Homes to take place on 31 December 2005.

### Consultation

Consultation about this instrument has taken place with Scottish Homes.

### **Financial Effects**

The instrument has no financial effects on the Scottish Executive, local government or on business.
