Relevant material imported into Switzerland from another third country which, if it would normally be permitted to be landed in Scotland if accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate, may be accompanied by a Swiss plant passport(1) or may be landed without phytosanitary documentation(2)

- 5. Parts of plants, other than fruit or seeds, of—
 - (a) leafy vegetables of Apium graveolens L. or Ocimum L.;
 - (b) cut flowers of *Aster* spp., *Eryngium* L., *Hypericum* L., *Lisianthus* L., *Rosa* L. or *Trachelium* L., originating in any country outside Europe; cut flowers of *Orchidaceae*; or
 - (c) Acer saccharum Marsh. originating in the USA or Canada, Camellia sp., conifers (Coniferales), Dendranthema (DC) Des Moul., Dianthus L., Gypsophilia L., Pelargonium L'Hérit. ex Ait., Populus L., Prunus L. originating in any country outside Europe, Quercus L. or Solidago L.
