### Swiss plant passports

#### PART B

Relevant material imported into Switzerland from another third country which, if it would normally be permitted to be landed in Scotland if accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate, may be accompanied by a Swiss plant passport<sup>(1)</sup> or may be landed without phytosanitary documentation<sup>(2)</sup>

5. Parts of plants, other than fruit or seeds, of–
- (a) leafy vegetables of *Apium graveolens* L. or *Ocimum* L.;
  - (b) cut flowers of *Aster* spp., *Eryngium* L., *Hypericum* L., *Lisianthus* L., *Rosa* L. or *Trachelium* L., originating in any country outside Europe; cut flowers of *Orchidaceae*; or
  - (c) *Acer saccharum* Marsh. originating in the USA or Canada, *Camellia* sp., conifers (*Coniferales*), *Dendranthema* (DC) Des Moul., *Dianthus* L., *Gypsophilia* L., *Pelargonium* L'Hérit. ex Ait., *Populus* L., *Prunus* L. originating in any country outside Europe, *Quercus* L. or *Solidago* L.
