The Transfer of Functions from the Strathclyde
Passenger Transport Authority and the Strathclyde
Passenger Transport Executive to the West of
Scotland Transport Partnership Order 2006

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the Strathclyde Passenger Transport Area” means the passenger transport area of the Strathclyde Passenger Transport Authority designated by order under section 40(4) of the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994⁽¹⁾; and

“the West of Scotland Transport Partnership” means the Transport Partnership established by the Regional Transport Partnerships (Establishment, Constitution and Membership) (Scotland) Order 2005⁽²⁾.
