

EXECUTIVE NOTE

THE TITLE CONDITIONS (SCOTLAND) ACT 2003 (CONSERVATION BODIES) AMENDMENT (NO. 2) ORDER 2006

(S.S.I 2006/130)

The powers to make this Order are conferred by section 38(7) of the Title Conditions (Scotland) Act 2003.

Policy Objectives

This Order amends the Title Conditions (Scotland) Act 2003 (Conservation Bodies) Order 2003 by removing Glasgow Conservation Trust West from the Schedule to that Order.

The Title Conditions (Scotland) Act 2003 gives Scottish Ministers the power to specify that a conservation body shall cease to be designated as such. Glasgow Conservation Trust West has asked that its name be removed from the list of conservation bodies as it is to wind up its affairs as of 31 March 2006.

A conservation body is able to enforce certain conditions in the title deeds of property that ensure it is used with certain conservation objectives in mind.

On 8 March 2006 an amending Order was laid in Parliament adding Aberdeen City Heritage Trust to the list of conservation bodies. Unfortunately we did not receive notification from Glasgow Conservation Trust West of its winding up until 9 March 2006 hence the need for a further Order to be made.

Financial Effects

The instrument has no financial effect on the Scottish Executive, local government or on business.
