The Sea Fishing (Enforcement of Community Quota and Third Country Fishing Measures) (Scotland) Order 2006

Offences

- 9. –
- (1) Where there is, in respect of-
 - (a) any Scottish fishing boat wherever it may be; or
- (b) any Community fishing boat or third country fishing boat within the Scottish zone, a contravention of, or failure to comply with, any Community quota measure, the master, the owner and the charterer (if any) shall each be guilty of an offence.
 - (2) Where there is in respect of-
 - (a) a Scottish fishing boat wherever it may be; or
- (b) any Community fishing boat or third country fishing boat within the Scottish zone, a contravention of, or failure to comply with any specified Community provision, the master, the owner and the charterer (if any) shall each be guilty of an offence.
- (3) Where there is, in respect of any third country fishing boat within the Scottish zone, a contravention of, or failure to comply with, any Community third country fishing measure, the master, the owner and the charterer (if any) shall each be guilty of an offence.
- (4) Nothing in this Order shall be taken to constitute an offence to land, from a Scottish fishing boat, an unsorted catch at a harbour outwith Scotland where sampling programmes mentioned in paragraph 1 of Article 9 are in place.
