**The Avian Influenza (Preventive Measures)
(Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2006**

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Avian Influenza (Preventive Measures) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2006 and shall come into force on 22nd June 2006.

Amendment of the Avian Influenza (Preventive Measures) Regulations 2005

2. In regulation 2 (interpretation) of the Avian Influenza (Preventive Measures) Regulations 2005(1) for the definition of “the Commission Decision” substitute—

““the Commission Decision” means Commission Decision [2005/734/EC](#) laying down biosecurity measures to reduce the risk of transmission of highly pathogenic avian influenza caused by Influenza virus A subtype H5N1 from birds living in the wild to poultry and other captive birds and providing for an early detection system in areas at particular risk(2) as amended, the last amending instrument being Commission Decision [2006/405/EC\(3\)](#)”.
