**The National Assistance (Sums for Personal Requirements) (Scotland) Regulations 2007**

**Citation, commencement and extent**

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the National Assistance (Sums for Personal Requirements) (Scotland) Regulations 2007 and shall come into force on 9th April 2007.

(2) These Regulations extend to Scotland only.

**Sum needed for personal requirements**

2. For the purposes of section 22(4) of the National Assistance Act 1948, as applied by section 87(3) and (4) of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 (the amount which a local authority shall assume that a person will need for his or her personal requirements per week), the amount prescribed is £20.45<sup>(1)</sup>.

**Revocation**

3. The National Assistance (Sums for Personal Requirements) (Scotland) Regulations 2006<sup>(2)</sup> are revoked.
