EXECUTIVE NOTE TO

THE FEED (CORN GLUTEN FEED AND BREWERS GRAINS) (EMERGENCY CONTROLS) (SCOTLAND) REVOCATION REGULATIONS 2007 SSI 2007/493

The above instrument is made under powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972.

Policy Objectives

1. This instrument transposes Commission Decision 2007/157/EC of 7 March 2007, repealing Commission Decision 2005/317/EC of 18 April 2005, which introduced emergency controls on imports from the USA of maize products potentially containing or derived from the unauthorised GM line Bt10.

Legislative Background

- 2. Commission Decision 2005/317/EC which was transposed into law in Scotland by the Feed (Corn Gluten Feed and Brewers Grains) (Emergency Controls) (Scotland) Regulations 2005 required importers to provide a certificate of analysis to show that consignments from the USA of two maize products (corn gluten feed and brewers grains) were free of Bt10 GM maize before they were placed on the market. The Bt10 GM line has not been authorised for use in the EU. In January 2007 the Commission reviewed the position and adopted Commission Decision 2007/157/EC repealing the emergency controls. This measure came into force on 8 March 2007, the date of its publication in the Official Journal on the European Union.
- 3. Action to implement Commission Decision 2007/157/EC in the UK had to be deferred. This was because public consultation and transposition was delayed by the timing of elections in Scotland and Wales. To ensure a common coming-into-force date for the measure in all parts of the UK, consultation was deferred until after the Scottish and Welsh elections in May 2007.

Extent

4. The Regulations extend to Scotland only. Parallel legislation will be made in England, Wales and Northern Ireland.

Policy background

- 5. The GM variety Bt10 is unauthorised anywhere in the world. However in March 2005, the European Commission was advised by the US authorities that Bt10 maize seed had been supplied to some US farmers in error. As a result it was possible that some exports of maize products to the EU contained the Bt10 variety.
- 6. Commission Decision 2005/317/EC required Member States to undertake random sampling and analysis of consignments from the USA of corn gluten feed and brewers

grain to verify the absence of Bt10. Only one instance of Bt10 entering the EU was detected, in May 2005, when the consignment in question was determined to have been shipped from the USA before the results of its analysis had become available. The Decision was reviewed at the February 2007 meeting of the Standing Committee on the Food Chain and Animal Health, when it was noted that the USA had taken action to ensure that Bt10 would not be further propagated or distributed. It was therefore agreed that Commission Decision 2005/317/EC could be repealed, and Commission Decision 2007/157/EC was adopted.

Consultation

7. The public consultation in Scotland took place over a three week period in July 2007, and involved a range of animal feed and GM stakeholders including industry trade associations, enforcement bodies and others (see attached list). This short consultation period was used because the transposing Regulations simply give effect to a Commission Decision repealing emergency controls the need for which had demonstrably passed. No comments were received in response to the Scottish consultation.

Guidance

8. The Agency does not consider that guidance on this new measure is necessary as its provisions are largely self-explanatory.

Impact

9. A Regulatory Impact Assessment is not attached to this memorandum. This is because the Regulations remove rather than impose an administrative burden on merchants and importers, who will no longer be required to provide a certificate of analysis, and on enforcement authorities who will no longer be required to check that imported consignments are accompanied by a certificate. A Regulatory Impact Assessment is not therefore considered necessary.
