
# SCHEDULE

Article 12(1)(a)

# Marking of meat and meat products from wild game birds originating in a protection, surveillance or restricted zone

- 1. The mark referred to in article 12(1)(a) must be-
  - (a) in the form set out in paragraph 2;
  - (b) of the dimensions referred to in paragraph 2 or of proportionate dimensions; and
  - (c) legible to the naked eye.
- 2. The mark must be in the following form-



- (a) (a) UK letters 8 mm high;
- (b) XXXX (where XXXX is the approval number of the premises, as referred to in [<sup>F1</sup>point 6] of Part B of Section I of Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 853/2004<sup>M1</sup>) numbers 11 mm high;
- (c) diameter (to outer edge of border) not less than 30 mm;
- (d) thickness of border -3 mm.
