The A82 Trunk Road (Glencoe Village) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2008

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(**b**), hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Glencoe Village) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2008 and shall come into force on 3^{rd} May 2008.

Restriction of speed

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
