ROAD TRAFFIC

The M90 Trunk Road (Gairneybridge to Milnathort) (Temporary 50mph Speed Limit) Order 2008

Made	23 rd June 2008
Coming into force	9 th July 2008

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Roads Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$ and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1) of that Act they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule to the Order should be restricted as hereinafter provided because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the M90 Trunk Road (Gairneybridge to Milnathort) (Temporary 50mph Speed Limit) Order 2008, comes into force on 9^{th} July 2008 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 15^{th} July 2008.

Temporary speed restriction

2. No person shall drive any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule at a speed exceeding 50 mph when a restriction is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions $2002(\mathbf{a})$.

That length of the M90/A90 Inverkeithing – Fraserburgh Trunk Road from a point 2.5 kilometres or thereby south of junction 5, Gairneybridge, northwards to a point 2.5 kilometres or thereby north of junction 7, Milnathort, a distance of 12.66 kilometres or thereby.
