ROAD TRAFFIC

The A82 Trunk Road (Scottish Open Golf Tournament, Loch Lomond) (Special Event) (Temporary Restriction of Speed) Order 2008

Made Ist July 2008 Coming into force 9th July 2008

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 88(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 88(1) of that Act, they are of the opinion that a temporary restriction of speed at which motor vehicles are driven on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is desirable in the interests of safety and for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Scottish Open Golf Tournament, Loch Lomond) (Special Event) (Temporary Restriction of Speed) Order 2008 and comes into force on 9th July 2008 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 13th July 2008.

Temporary speed restriction

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30mph daily between 0500 hours until 2200 hours.

SCHEDULE

That length of the A82 Dalnottar - Inverness Trunk Road from a point 200 metres or thereby south of the unclassified access road to Midross to a point 250 metres or thereby north of the A817 Glen Fruin Road Junction (Loch Lomond – Garelochead Road), a distance of 2.75 kilometres or thereby.
