**The Potatoes Originating in Poland (Notification)  
(Scotland) Amendment Order 2008**

**Amendment of article 2**

**3.** In article 2 (interpretation)–

(a) omit the definition of “Polish Potatoes” and insert–

““Polish potato” means any potato which is imported, other than potatoes for planting, and which the person importing it knows or has reasonable cause to suspect to have been grown in the Republic of Poland during the year 2003 or subsequently;”;  
and

(b) omit the definition of “seed potato”.
