The Fish Farming Businesses (Record Keeping) (Scotland) Order 2008

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. This Order may be cited as the Fish Farming Businesses (Record Keeping) (Scotland) Order 2008 and shall come into force on 10th November 2008.

2. In this Order “facility” means any pond, tank, pen, cage or raceway in which fish are kept.

Information about fish farms

3. A person who carries on a business of fish farming shall in respect of each site at which fish are farmed in the course of the business—

- (a) in relation to the prevention, control and reduction of parasites on fish farms, compile the records that are specified in Schedule 1; and
- (b) in relation to the containment, prevention of escape and recovery of fish from fish farms, compile the records that are specified in Schedule 2,

and in both cases shall retain the records for a period of 3 years.
