BANKRUPTCY

The Bankruptcy (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2008

Made - - - - - *6th October 2008*
Laid before the Scottish
Parliament - - - - - *7th October 2008*
Coming into force - - - - - *14th November 2008*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 5(4C)(a) and (b), 72(1) and 73(1) of the Bankruptcy (Scotland) Act 1985⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.
