ROAD TRAFFIC

The A82 Trunk Road (Ballachulish) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2008

Made

27th November 2008

Coming into force

11th December 2008

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

They have complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987^(b) before making this Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Ballachulish) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2008 and comes into force on 11th December 2008.

Restriction of speed

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

That length of the A82 Dalnottar - Inverness Trunk Road at Ballachulish from a point 34 metres or thereby east of the west gable of Braehead Cottage to a point 100 metres or thereby west of the centreline of the junction to Lochside Cottages, Ballachulish, a distance of 2042 metres or thereby.
