

EXECUTIVE NOTE
THE FUNDABLE BODIES (SCOTLAND) ORDER 2008
SSI 2008/412

The above instrument was made in exercise of the powers conferred by section 7(1) of the Further and Higher Education (Scotland) Act 2005 (“the 2005 Act”). The instrument is subject to affirmative resolution procedure.

Policy Objectives

The Scottish Further and Higher Education Funding Council (“the Funding Council”) may only fund institutions listed in schedule 2 to the 2005 Act. The purpose of this instrument is to modify Schedule 2 of the 2005 Act. The modifications are to:

- substitute “Central College of Commerce” with “Central College Glasgow” as a result of the College changing its name;
- substitute “Glasgow College of Nautical Science” with “Glasgow College of Nautical Studies”, to correct an error in schedule 2; and
- remove “Napier University” and insert “Edinburgh Napier University”, as a result of the University resolving to change its name on 16 June 2008 and the Privy Council consenting to the change of name by letter dated 23 September 2008.

Approval

The Funding Council has approved the changes as required by the 2005 Act.

Financial Effects

A Regulatory Impact Assessment has not been prepared as this instrument has no financial effects on the Scottish Government, local government or on business.
