Development plan schemes

- **24.** In addition to those matters specified by the Act, a development plan scheme must state the timetable [FI proposed] (specifying the proposed month) by the strategic development planning authority or the planning authority, as the case may be, with regard to—
 - (a) publication of its main issues report;
 - (b) publication of its proposed strategic development plan or local development plan; and
 - (c) submission of its proposed strategic development plan or local development plan to the Scottish Ministers.
