ROAD TRAFFIC

The South East Unit Trunk Roads Area (Temporary Prohibitions of Traffic, Temporary Prohibitions of Overtaking and Temporary Speed Restrictions) (No.12) Order 2008

Made 19th December 2008

Coming into force 1st January 2009

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1) and (4), 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited as hereinafter provided because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said lengths of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the South East Unit Trunk Roads Area (Temporary Prohibitions of Traffic, Temporary Prohibitions of Overtaking and Temporary Speed Restrictions) (No. 12) Order 2008, comes into force on 1st January 2009 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 31st March 2009.

Interpretation

2. In this Order a reference to a numbered column is to the column in the Schedule to this Order bearing that number.

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22), Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by the Scotland Act 1998 (Consequential Modifications) Order 2001 (S.I. 2001/1400)) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Temporary prohibition on use of a road

3. Subject to Article 6, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on each length of road specified in column 1 when a prohibition is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagram 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a).

Temporary prohibition on overtaking

4.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this Article, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other moving vehicle on each length of road specified in column 1 when a prohibition is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 632 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002.

(2) Nothing in paragraph (1) of this Article shall prohibit any person from using, or permitting the use of, any vehicle in such a way that it overtakes a cycle, motor cycle, tricycle or any other vehicle not being a motor vehicle in accordance with section 140 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(b).

Temporary speed restriction

5.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this Article, no person shall drive any vehicle on the lengths of road specified in column 1 of Parts 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding that specified in column 2 when a restriction is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002.

(2) When convoy working is in operation and indicated by one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagrams 7011, 7025, 7026, 7027, 7028 and 7029 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002, no person shall drive any vehicle on the lengths of road specified in column 1 of Part 3 of the Schedule at a speed exceeding 10 mph when a restriction is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002.

Exemption for emergency and works vehicles

6. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes or a vehicle while being used for carrying out the works.

1. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound on slip road at Junction 2 (Claylands), a distance of 1 kilometre or thereby.
2. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound off slip road at Junction 4 (Whitburn), a distance of 390 metres or thereby.
3. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound on slip road at Junction 4 (Whitburn), a distance of 400 metres or thereby.
4. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound combined on/off slip road at Chapelhall Junction, a distance of 340 metres or thereby.
5. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound combined on/off slip road at Chapelhall Junction, a distance of 180 metres or thereby.
6. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound off slip road at Eurocentral Junction, a distance of 470 metres or thereby.
7. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound on slip road at Eurocentral Junction, a distance of 525 metres or thereby.
8. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound off slip road at Eurocentral Junction, a distance of 565 metres or thereby.
9. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound on slip road at Eurocentral Junction, a distance of 465 metres or thereby.
10. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound combined on/off slip road at Shawhead Junction, a distance of 360 metres or thereby.
11. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound combined on/off slip road at Shawhead Junction, a distance of 400 metres or thereby.
12. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound off slip road (dedicated to the A725 southbound) at Shawhead Junction, a distance of 280 metres or thereby.
13. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound combined on/off slip road at Bargeddie Junction, a distance of 200 metres or thereby.
14. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound combined on/off slip road at Bargeddie Junction, a distance of 190 metres or thereby.
15. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the westbound off slip road at Bailleston Junction, a distance of 375 metres or thereby.
16. That length of the M8/A8 Edinburgh – Greenock Trunk Road being the eastbound on slip road at Bailleston Junction, a distance of 315 metres or thereby.
17. That length of the A1 Edinburgh – Berwick Upon Tweed Trunk Road from the A1107 (Eyemouth) Junction to the Cockburnspath Roundabout, a distance of 2.1 kilometres or thereby.
18. That length of the M80/A80 Glasgow – Stirling Trunk Road being the southbound off slip road at Junction 4 (Haggs), a distance of 280 metres or thereby.

20. That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh – Stirling – Thurso Trunk Road being the northbound and southbound carriageways from Junction 9 (Bannockburn) southbound off slip road to Junction 7 (Kinnaird) southbound on slip road, a distance of 9.8 kilometres or thereby.	40 mph
