**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The M80/A80 Trunk Road (Temporary Width Restriction of Traffic) Order 2008

*Made* 1<sup>st</sup> February 2008

*Coming into force* 7th February 2008

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) and (4), section 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on that length of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited as hereinafter provided because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with Section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

**Citation, commencement and cessation**

1. This Order may be cited as the M80/A80 Trunk Road (Temporary Width Restriction of Traffic) Order 2008 and comes into force on 7<sup>th</sup> February 2008 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2008.

**Temporary restriction of use of vehicles**

2. Subject to Article 3 of this order, no person shall cause, or permit any vehicle to proceed on the length of road specified in the Schedule if the width exceeds 3.2 metres, when such restriction is identified as applying to part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 629 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b).

### **Exemption for emergency and works vehicles**

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes, or a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

That length of road being the westbound and eastbound carriageways on the M80/A80 Glasgow to Stirling Trunk Road from Junction 5 (Bankhead) to Junction 9 (Pirnhill), a distance of 10.7 kilometres or thereby.
