**AMENDMENTS TO THE CEREAL SEED
(SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2005**

Marketing of seed

- 4.** In regulation 6 (marketing of seed)–
- (a) in paragraph (1)(b)(i) for “Pre-basic Seed, fully certified Basic Seed or Seed of a Certified Generation” substitute “Pre-basic Seed, fully certified Basic Seed, Seed of a Certified Generation or seed of a Conservation Variety”;
 - (b) for paragraph (2) substitute–
 - “(2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to the marketing of seed which has not yet been fully certified if–
 - (a) the seed is marketed for processing;
 - (b) the identity of the seed is ensured; and
 - (i) the seed has been harvested by an official field inspection to satisfy the conditions specified in Part I of Schedule 4 or Annex I (crop conditions) of the Cereal Seed Directive for the relevant category of seed; or
 - (ii) the seed of a Conservation Variety has been harvested from a crop which has been found to satisfy the conditions specified in Part III of Schedule 4A.”;
 - (c) in paragraph (3)–
 - (i) delete “either”;
 - (ii) after “Schedule 2,” insert “the examination referred to in paragraph 2(b) of Part I of Schedule 4A”(1).
