**The Control of Salmonella in Turkey
Flocks (Scotland) Order 2009**

Records of samples

- 6.—(1) The occupier must, as soon as is reasonably practicable after taking a sample, record—
- (a) the type of sample taken;
 - (b) the date on which the sample was taken;
 - (c) where there is more than one turkey flock on the holding, the identification of the turkey flock from which the sample was taken;
 - (d) the age of the turkey flock sampled;
 - (e) the laboratory to which the sample was sent; and
 - (f) the intended date of slaughter of the turkey flock sampled.
- (2) The occupier must record the result of each test when it is received from the laboratory.
