TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING

The Town and Country Planning (Grounds for Declining to Follow Recommendations) (Scotland) Regulations 2009

Made - - - - - *12th February 2009*

Coming into force - - - - - *28th February 2009*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 19(10)(a)(i) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 275(7A) of that Act, a draft of this instrument has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Scottish Parliament:

(1) 1997 c. 8. The functions of the Secretary of State under the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 (“the 1997 Act”) were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c. 46). Section 19(10)(a)(i) was inserted by section 2 of the [Planning etc. \(Scotland\) Act 2006 \(asp 17\)](#) and section 275 was further amended by section 54(16)(f) of that Act.
