**The Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order and  
Trees in Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Regulations 2010**

*Made* - - - - - *2nd December 2010*  
*Laid before the Scottish*  
*Parliament* - - - - - *6th December 2010*  
*Coming into force* - - - - - *1st February 2011*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 160(8), 161(3) and (4), 173 and 275 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997<sup>(1)</sup> and all other powers enabling them to do so.

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).
