ROAD TRAFFIC

The A90 Trunk Road (Walnut Grove) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2010

Made
Coming into force

1st March 2010
15th March 2010

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1) and (4), 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule should be prohibited from making any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they are satisfied that there is an alternative route suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A90 Trunk Road (Walnut Grove) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2010, comes into force on 15th March 2010 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 9th April 2010.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. Subject to articles 3 and 4, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of that length of road by means of the traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 613 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Permission or direction of police constable

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

Exemption for emergency and works vehicles

4. No provision of this Order shall apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes or a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

PART 1

That length of the M90/A90 Inverkeithing - Fraserburgh Trunk Road, from a point 1 kilometre or thereby east of the eastmost junction to Walnut Grove, westwards to the junction with the off slip road to Perth at Barnhill junction, a distance of 2 kilometres or thereby.

PART 2

1. All left turns from the southbound M90/A90 Inverkeithing - Fraserburgh Trunk Road to the eastmost junction to Walnut Grove.
2. All left turns from the eastmost junction from Walnut Grove to the southbound M90/A90 Inverkeithing - Fraserburgh Trunk Road.

THE A90 TRUNK ROAD (WALNUT GROVE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF SPECIFIED TURNS) ORDER 2010

THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS give notice that they have made the above Order temporarily prohibiting traffic on that length of the M90/A90 Inverkeithing – Fraserburgh Trunk Road, from a point 1 kilometre or thereby east of the eastmost junction to Walnut Grove, westwards to the junction with the off slip road to Perth at Barnhill junction, a distance of 2 kilometres or thereby from making any of the following turns:

1. All left turns from the southbound M90/A90 Inverkeithing - Fraserburgh Trunk Road to the eastmost junction to Walnut Grove.
2. All left turns from the eastmost junction from Walnut Grove to the southbound M90/A90 Inverkeithing - Fraserburgh Trunk Road.

The Order, which is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said lengths of road to allow the installation of a cantilever variable message sign to take place, will be in operation from 15th March 2010 until midnight on 9th April 2010, but will only have effect in relation to such part or parts of the lengths of road as are indicated by the appropriate traffic signs. It is anticipated that the proposed works will be carried out over a single night but due to the fact that high winds can disrupt erection of the sign, four weeks from 15th March 2010 have been allowed to account for unforeseen circumstances and/or bad weather. The Order does not apply to vehicles while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes, vehicles being used for carrying out the works or to acts done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.
