**The Parole Board (Scotland) Amendment Rules 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *21st February 2011*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Rules in exercise of the power conferred by section 20(4) of the Prisoners and Criminal Proceedings (Scotland) Act 1993<sup>(1)</sup> and all other powers enabling them to do so.
