**The Plastic Kitchenware (Conditions on Imports  
from China) (Scotland) Regulations 2011**

**Expenses arising from official controls**

7.—(1) Expenses charged pursuant to [<sup>F1</sup>Article 80 of Regulation 2017/625] by a food authority to an importer in connection with the checks mentioned in Article 6(1) are payable by the importer on the written demand of the food authority.

(2) Where a food authority identifies non-compliance—

- (a) with the requirements of Article 3(1), (2) or (3) or Article 4; or
- (b) following the checks mentioned in Article 6(1)(b),

expenses charged pursuant to [<sup>F2</sup>Article 138(4) of Regulation 2017/625] by a food authority to an importer are payable by the importer on the written demand of the food authority.
