The National Health Service (Pharmaceutical Services) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2011

Made - - - - 20th January 2011
Laid before the Scottish

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(5), 27, 105(7), 106(a) and 108(1) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with paragraph 24(1) and (3) of Schedule 7 to the Tribunals, Courts and Enforcement Act 2007(2) they have consulted the Administrative Justice and Tribunals Council and it has consulted its Scottish Committee.
