The Ayr Road Route (M77) (Speed Limit) Amendment Regulations 2011

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 17(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so. In accordance with section 134(2)(2) of that Act they have consulted such representative organisations as they think fit.
