Importation from a third country

[^{F1}Supervision and monitoring consignments

15. Where a consignment is required to be taken under supervision from a border control post [^{F2}(within the meaning of Article 3(38) of the Official Controls Regulation)] to a specific destination in [^{F3}Great Britain]—

- (a) the movement must be under customs supervision if this is specified in the CHED; and
- (b) on arrival, the occupier of any destination premises in Scotland must immediately notify the Scottish Ministers of its arrival.]
