**The Pollution Prevention and
Control (Scotland) Regulations 2012**

PART I

GENERAL

Interpretation: enactments etc.

3.—(1) In these Regulations—

“1990 Act” means the Environmental Protection Act 1990 ^{M1},

“2000 Regulations” means the Pollution Prevention and Control (Scotland) Regulations 2000 ^{M3},
