

## SCHEDULE 2

### SOLVENT EMISSIONS

#### PART 2

##### SEPA functions

9. SEPA may permit emissions from the coating activities described in row 9 of the Table in Part 1 that cannot be carried out under contained conditions to exceed an emissions limit required under <sup>F1</sup>paragraph 7(1)(e)], provided that—

- (a) it is not technically and economically feasible to comply with that paragraph, and
- (b) SEPA ensures that the operator of the installation uses the best available techniques in respect of those emissions.
