The Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2013

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 182, 186 and 275 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.
