### Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 **S**

1. In the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 <sup>M1</sup>, in section 97 (establishment of Commission for Local Authority Accounts in Scotland), for subsection (7A) substitute—

“(7A) In subsection (7), “EEA State” means a member State, Norway, Iceland or Lichtenstein.”.
