The charge: requirement to charge

Requirement to charge

6.—(1) A supplier must charge for a single use carrier bag supplied new—

- (a) at the place where goods are supplied, for the purpose of enabling the goods to be taken away; or
- (b) for the purpose of enabling the goods to be delivered to any person.

(2) The amount that a supplier must charge for a single use carrier bag is the amount that will ensure that the consideration paid by the person supplied with the bag is, for each such bag, not less than 5 pence.

Circumstances in which the requirement to charge does not apply

7.— $[^{F1}(1)]$ The requirement to charge in regulation 6 does not apply in relation to the supply of a single use carrier bag if the bag is used for a purpose described in paragraph 1 of the Schedule.

 $[^{F2}(2)$ Until 0001 hours on $[^{F3}31$ May 2021], the requirement to charge in regulation 6 does not apply in relation to the supply of a single use carrier bag if the bag is used for a purpose described in paragraph 1A of the schedule.]
