The Outer Hebrides (Landing of Crabs and Lobsters) Order 2015

Prohibition on landing crippled female lobsters caught in specified waters

- 7.—(1) The landing in Scotland of any crippled female lobster, caught in the waters specified in paragraph 2 of Schedule 2, is prohibited.
 - (2) In this article, "crippled female lobster" means a female lobster missing—
 - (a) part of, or all of, its crusher claw; or
 - (b) part of, or all of, its cutter claw.
 - (3) Landing from foreign fishing boats is excepted from the prohibition imposed by paragraph (1).
