**The National Health Service (Payments
and Remission of Charges) (Miscellaneous
Amendments) (Scotland) Regulations 2015**

Made - - - - *15th September 2015*
Laid before the Scottish
Parliament - - - - *17th September 2015*
Coming into force - - *1st November 2015*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 75A and 105(7) of, and paragraph 2A of Schedule 11 to, the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Paragraph 2A of Schedule 11 was inserted by the Health and Social Security Act 1984 (c.48), Schedule 1, Part II, paragraph 7 and amended by the Health and Medicines Act 1988 (c.49), section 13(2) and (5) and the Smoking, Health and Social Care (Scotland) Act 2005 (asp 13), section 13. Section 108(1) contains definitions of “prescribed” and “regulations” relevant to the exercise of the statutory powers under which these Regulations are made. The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).
