**The Community Right to Buy (Scotland) Regulations 2015**

**PART 7**

**Ballots**

**Proxy Votes**

**16.**—(1) A person eligible to vote in the ballot may make a request, in writing, to the balloter to be permitted a proxy vote.

(2) A request under paragraph (1) must—

- (a) state the name and address of the person eligible to vote;
- (b) state the name and address of the person whom the person eligible to vote wishes to appoint as a proxy;
- (c) be signed by the person eligible to vote;
- (d) contain a statement confirming that the person who is eligible to vote has consulted the proxy and that the proxy is capable and willing of acting as proxy; and
- (e) be received by the balloter not later than 1700 hours on the day before the date on which the ballot paper must be returned.

(3) The balloter must permit a proxy vote to a person who makes a valid request in accordance with paragraphs (1) and (2).
