Failure to comply with any condition, or to ensure that the permit (or a copy of it) is prominently displayed at the event, is an offence under section 17(4) of the Air Weapons and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2015.

It is an offence under section 30 of the Air Weapons and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2015 for a person to fail to take reasonable precautions for the safe custody of an air weapon possessed by the person, or to fail to report as soon as reasonably practicable to the Chief Constable of the Police Service of Scotland the loss or theft of an air weapon possessed by the person.
