**The Bankruptcy (Scotland) Regulations 2016**

**PART 4**

Administration of sequestration

**Abandonment of heritable property by trustee**

**24.**—(1) Where a trustee in sequestration has abandoned to the debtor any heritable property, notice of abandonment for the purposes of section 87(8) of the Act must be—

- (a) where the trustee is not AiB, in Form 15; or
- (b) where AiB is the trustee, in Form 16.

(2) Where AiB records a certified copy notice of abandonment under section 87(9) of the Act, it may be sent electronically to the Keeper containing an electronic signature in a form to be agreed between AiB and the Keeper.

(3) The Accountant in Bankruptcy, Depute Accountant in Bankruptcy or any other person authorised by the Accountant in Bankruptcy must certify such a copy on behalf of AiB <sup>M1</sup>.
