The Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) Regulations 2017

PART 1

INTRODUCTORY

Citation, commencement, application and extent

- **1.**—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) Regulations 2017 and come into force on 16th May 2017.
 - (2) Subject to Part 12, these Regulations apply in the case of—
 - (a) an application under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989(1) for consent to construct, extend or operate a generating station;
 - (b) an application under section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989(2) for consent to install or keep installed an electric line above ground;
 - (c) a direction under section 57(2) or (2ZA) (deemed planning permission for development with government authorisation) of the 1997 Act(3);
 - (d) an application for multi-stage consent; and
 - (e) a variation application.
 - (3) These Regulations extend to Scotland only.
