**Competent authority – avoidance of conflict of interest**

**36.**—(1) The <sup>F1</sup>... Scottish Ministers are to perform their duties arising under these Regulations in an objective manner and so as not to find themselves in a situation giving rise to a conflict of interest.

(2) Where the [<sup>F2</sup>Scottish Ministers] are to consider an application for EIA consent made by the [<sup>F2</sup>Scottish Ministers] they are to implement within their organisation of administrative competences an appropriate separation between conflicting functions when performing their duties under these Regulations.
