PRELIMINARY

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Mental Health (Scotland) Act 2015 (Commencement No. 5 and Transitional Provisions) Order 2017 and comes into force on 15th September 2017.
 - (2) In this Order—
 - "the Act" means the Mental Health (Scotland) Act 2015;
 - "the 2005 Order" means the Mental Health (Care and Treatment) (Scotland) Act 2003 (Transitional and Savings Provisions) Order 2005(1);
 - "the 2003 Act" means the Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 2003(2);
 - "the 2003 Mental Health Act" means the Mental Health (Care and Treatment) (Scotland) Act 2003(3);
 - "the 1995 Act" means the Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1995(4); and
 - "the 1984 Act" means the Mental Health (Scotland) Act 1984(5).
- (3) For the purposes of articles 3 to 8 of this Order, "the appointed day" means 15th September 2017.
