ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A78 Trunk Road (Gallowgate Street, Largs) (Temporary
Traffic Restrictions) Order 2017**

Made - - - - - 27th January 2017

Coming into force - - - - - 6th February 2017

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A78 Trunk Road (Gallowgate Street, Largs) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2017, comes into force on 6th February 2017 and ceases to have effect on 20th February 2017.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road, or a part or parts of the length of road, specified in the schedule of this Order when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, by means of the traffic sign described in item 8 (diagram 7105 – position of barrier to mark the length of road closed or to guide traffic past an obstruction) of the sign table in part 6 of schedule 13 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(b).

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (inserted by the 1991 Act, schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54) (as amended by S.S.I. 2001/1400). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Prohibition and restriction on waiting, loading and unloading

3. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle to wait, load or unload on the length of road, or a part or parts of the length of road, specified in the schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in items 19 (diagram 636 – temporary prohibition of waiting except loading and unloading) and 20 (diagram 636.1 – temporary prohibition of loading and unloading) of the sign table in part 6 of schedule 13 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2017.

Exemptions

4. No prohibition or restriction imposed by this Order applies to—
- (a) a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

Articles 2 and 3

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A78 Greenock – Prestwick Trunk Road being Gallowgate Street, Largs from a point 38 metres or thereby north of its junction with Fort Street in a northerly direction to a point 23 metres south or thereby south of its junction with Gallowgate Lane a distance of 41 metres or thereby.
