The National Health Service (General Dental Services) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2017

Made - - - - 7th September 2017

Laid before the Scottish

Parliament - - - - 11th September 2017

Coming into force in accordance with regulation 1

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 25(1), (2) and (2A), 28A(4), 105(7) and 106(a) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).
