1. Citation, commencement and interpretation

3. Rent-increase notice
4. Referral to a rent officer to determine the rent
5. Application to a rent officer to determine the additional amount of rent (if any) attributable to improvements
6. Notice to leave
7. Sub-tenancy notice to leave
