**The Functions of Health Boards
(Scotland) Amendment Order 2017**

Made - - - - 19th September 2017
*Laid before the Scottish
Parliament* - - - - 21st September 2017
Coming into force - - 6th November 2017

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(1) (a) and 105(7) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by virtue of section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).
