"boundary line" means a boundary delineated by a line as described in this schedule; "co-ordinate" means a co-ordinate defined on the World Geodetic System 1984 datum(1); co-ordinate "A" is 57° 53.842' North latitude and 005° 22.902' West longitude; co-ordinate "B" is 57° 53.911' North latitude and 005° 22.813' West longitude; co-ordinate "C" is 57° 53.741' North latitude and 005° 22.423' West longitude; and co-ordinate "D" is 57° 53.685' North latitude and 005° 22.470' West longitude.
